The resulting book of standards, NFPA70E, set forth guidelines and restrictions for protecting workers who install, maintain or repair electrical systems.

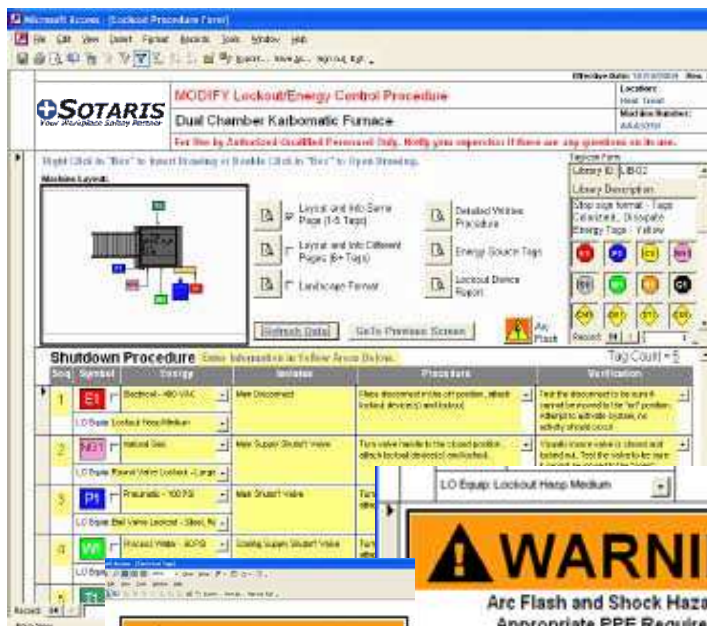
