OSHA 30-HOUR GENERAL INDUSTRY - SAFETY TRAINING PROGRAM

The 30-hour program is intended to provide a variety of training to people with some safety responsibility. Training is limited to a maximum of 7.5 student contact hours per day. The entire length of the training day may be longer than 7.5 hours when adding time for breaks and lunch.

We will tailor the classes to fit your company's particular needs and environment. At the successful completion of the course, attendees will be issued a certificate of completion and an official OSHA student course completion card. The class sizes can be from 3 to 40 students. Topics are to be selected from the below table.
